Under the joint supervision of the Executive Director, Provost Primary Care Network (PCN) and the Physician Lead, the Registered Nurse will provide a wide variety of comprehensive nursing services individuals, families, groups and the community. Within a multi-disciplinary environment, the Registered Nurse (RN) will work with Family Physicians in the community, other health professionals and local and regional programming to ensure high quality evidence-based health care is provided to the PCN's population.

In a 0.6 FTE position, the candidate will have a key role in health promotion and prevention and should possess experience in group facilitation and presenting or delivering health education.
