Tractor Pulls Set to Run for 7th Consecutive Year

Tractor pulls are gearing up for the seventh year in a row. And that many years even surprised organizer Kim Larson when he stopped to add it up.

Larson said that the pulls that are slated for this weekend at the fairgrounds will feature both local, Canadian and American pullers.

There will likely be 35 different units coming from across the continent.

Local pullers will include 14 year old Jordan Larson who will again be piloting a 2300 c.c., four cylinder machine. The engine came out of a turbocharged Thunderbird. Other pullers will be Jim, Cody, Kyle and Tanya Hayes as well as Doug Hall who will also have his sled here again this year.

Larson says the pulls get under way with the Kinsmen horse pulls
